Electronic Systems Honored for Philanthropy at HP Americas Partner Conference

Virginia Beach, Virginia – April 7, 2011 - Electronic Systems, Inc. (ESI) announced today that it has been recognized as a winner of the prestigious HP Partner in Excellence Award for corporate philanthropy during the 2011 HP Americas Partner Conference held last week in Las Vegas.

Electronic Systems was recognized with the Power of Technology in Community Innovation Award for their innovative philanthropic IT practices in support of the AAU Junior Olympic Games held last summer in Hampton Roads.

ESI donated over \$20,000 of equipment, service, and materials to keep the event running smoothly. This included a variety of computer hardware, print technology, software, and networking equipment for each event venue. As part of its donation, ESI also included the delivery, setup, and teardown of all equipment and provided an on-call maintenance technician to provide service during the event. ESI employees also volunteered at various events throughout the competition.

In total, ESI provided 408 computers, 183 printers, 123 multifunction devices, and 36 fax machines to the games. The equipment was spread out among 12 locations in five different cities during the two-week event. Each venue required careful attention to technology requirements, delivery logistics, and site operations.

"Whether supplying computers and networking equipment to a national event like the Junior Olympics, or rallying to support our local food banks through grass roots fundraising efforts, our employees have shown the tremendous impact that results when technology and service to the community are paired together."

They honored Electronic Systems for embracing HP's vision of integrating IT services in support of community needs by applying technology solutions that achieve a broad impact in their local communities.
